Dear Mr. Callander:

We have completed a review of the quarterly report status for the first quarter of 2015. According to our records, Triumph Motorcycles America, LTD's (Triumph) second quarterly report for safety recall 14V-548 and Triumph's first quarterly report for safety recall 14V-765 was due in this office on, or before, April 30, 2015. We have not received these reports and they are now overdue.

I urge your company to comply with its obligations and file these reports through its secure, online recalls account. This documentation is necessary to ensure the proper administration and progress of a safety recall designed to remove products that are defective and/or fail to meet minimum safety standards from U.S. roadways, and a serious responsibility for us both.

Your failure to produce the required documentation may result in a referral of your company to our Office of Chief Counsel for a potential enforcement action, including injunctive relief and/or civil penalties.
