## Important Safety Bulletin

We are writing regarding the use of the furnace in your Trails West RPM snowmobile trailer. When you purchased your Trails West RPM snowmobile trailer the owner's packet included the following warning:

**“Warning!** Be sure the furnace and all ignition systems are **“OFF”** during any type of refueling and while vehicle is in motion or being towed.”

In addition, many states and Canadian provinces require the furnace be turned off and propane bottles be shut off while the trailer is being towed.

Failure to heed the instructions above can and may result in melting of certain furnace components and in some cases has resulted in the incineration of the trailer and its contents. Never operate the furnace in your trailer when it is moving and never store containers of fuel or other combustible substances inside your trailer.

Only use your furnace and its integrated timer system in a manner consistent with all instructions and warnings.
