## IMPORTANT SAFETY RECALL 14502

FEBRUARY 2014

Dear INTERNATIONAL® Customer,

This notice applies to your vehicle identified on the enclosed card and is being sent to you in accordance with the requirements of the National Traffic and Motor Vehicle Safety Act.

Navistar has decided that a defect which relates to motor vehicle safety exists in certain DuraStar® model trucks built 11 January 2014 thru 23 January 2014 with steering feature codes 05PRG, 05PRR, 05PRU, 05PRV, or 05PSM.

### **REASON FOR THIS RECALL**

The mounting bolts that fasten the steering gear to the vehicle frame may not be the correct bolt specified. These bolts could yield resulting in either looseness of steering or potential for loss of steering if all four bolts were to yield.

### **RISK TO MOTOR VEHICLE SAFETY**

An unexpected reduction or loss of steering may result in a vehicle crash which may result in property damage, personal injury, or death.

### **DEFECT REMEDY**

The remedy will involve inspection for the incorrect steering gear mounting bolts and replacement of the bolts as necessary. Dealers have parts and instructions to repair your vehicle. The repair will be performed free of charge and take approximately 45 minutes to 4 hours to complete depending on which steering code is used on the vehicle.

### **ACTIONS YOU SHOULD TAKE**

If you own this vehicle, please schedule an appointment with any INTERNATIONAL® dealer to have your vehicle repaired. You can find your nearest dealer by calling 1-800-448-7825 or by using the dealer locator at <http://www.internationaltrucks.com>.

If you have already paid for repairs that corrected the defect, you may be eligible for reimbursement of certain repair expenses. Present your original repair paperwork and proof of payment to any INTERNATIONAL® dealer and your eligibility will be reviewed. You may also submit a claim using the enclosed Request for Reimbursement card.

If you are the lessor of this vehicle, please forward a copy of this notice to the lessee within ten days to comply with federal regulations.

If you do not own this vehicle, please fill out and return mail the enclosed card so that you will not be contacted again about this recall.

### **IF YOU NEED FURTHER ASSISTANCE**

If you believe that Navistar has failed to remedy the defect without charge or within a reasonable time, please follow the procedure described in the Owner Assistance Guide section in your Owner's Manual or call toll free 1-800-448-7825.
