This notice is sent to you in accordance with the requirements of the National Traffic and Motor Vehicle Safety Act.

Porsche has decided that a defect which relates to motor vehicle safety exists in certain 2014 Porsche GT3 vehicles. Our records show that you are the owner of a vehicle affected by this action.

Porsche has made the determination that engine crankcase damage may occur in certain 2014 Porsche GT3 models as a result of a loosened piston rod screw. Consequently, a piston rod can become loose and breach the crankcase. A breach of the crankcase of this nature could result in oil leakage and a subsequent fire if leaking oil strikes a sufficiently hot vehicle component.

Porsche is conducting a safety recall on these vehicles. The engine in your 2014 Porsche 911 GT3 will be replaced at no charge to you. The manufacturer, Porsche AG, is in the final phase of logistics planning and technical validation for an optimized piston rod screw connection, and production of new engines will begin the week of April 21, 2014. These new engines will be distributed worldwide for installation in all 2014 GT3 models built to date. Unfortunately, at this time it is impossible to predict precisely when a repair on your particular vehicle can take place. Be assured we will keep you and your authorized Porsche dealer abreast of engine delivery schedules as they become available.


