Model 587 Fog Lamp

Dear Peterbilt Customer:

This notice is sent to you in accordance with the requirements of the National Traffic and Motor Vehicle Safety Act.

Peterbilt Motors Company has decided that certain Peterbilt Model 587 manufactured between November 11, 2013 and March 07, 2014 fail to conform to Federal Motor Vehicle Safety Standard No. 108, Lamps and Reflective Devices, and Associated Equipment.

In the Model 587, when the high beam lights are turned on the fog lamps will go out but will automatically come back on after 10 seconds and remain illuminated unless manually turned off by the operator. The combination of the high beams and fog lights may exceed the allowable limits of light output under FMVSS 108. If both the fog lamps and high beams are illuminated at the same time, oncoming traffic may be blinded by excessive light, increasing the risk of a crash.

The problem is...	Defective software for fog lamp functionality
Correction...	Reflash using ESA and enable the fog lamp functionality
What you must do ...	Contact your dealer immediately to schedule an appointment

Please contact your Peterbilt dealer immediately to schedule an appointment for this repair. To find the nearest Peterbilt dealer, please visit Dealer Locator at www.Peterbilt.com. This repair should take approximately half an hour to complete, and will be performed at no charge to you. If you had this repair performed before you received this letter, you may be eligible to receive reimbursement for the cost of obtaining a pre-notification remedy of the problem associated with this recall.


