IMPORTANT SAFETY RECALL

NHTSA RECALL 14V-192

Dear Nissan LEAF Owner:

This notice is sent to you in accordance with the requirements of the National Traffic and Motor Vehicle Safety Act. Nissan has decided that a defect that relates to motor vehicle safety exists in certain 2014 model year Nissan LEAF vehicles. Our records indicate that you own or lease the vehicle on the inside of this notice.

Reason for Recall

Due to an isolated supplier process error, some of the front side member assembly components in your vehicle may not have been welded to specification. As a result, some front side member assembly welds may be missing. If these welds are missing, it may have an effect on vehicle crash performance and increase a risk of an injury.

What Nissan Will Do

Your vehicle will be inspected by the dealer to determine if the welds are missing. If so, Nissan will replace your vehicles with a new one, at no additional cost to you. During this time period, you will be provided with a loaner vehicle until you have received your new vehicle.

What You Should Do

Contact your Nissan dealer as soon as possible in order to arrange an appointment to have your vehicle inspected. Please bring this notice with you when you keep your service appointment. Instructions have been sent to your Nissan dealer.
