

Our records identify you as the owner of the vehicles shown on the attached list, affected by this recall.

REASON FOR THIS RECALL

Certain LFW model city transit buses, manufactured by NABI Bus, LLC, may have a steering column support bracket that has not been properly installed.

The steering column support bracket, which is welded to the dash assembly, may separate from the dash assembly, allowing the steering column to become loose. This could cause the driver to not be able to steer the vehicle properly, increasing the risk of a crash.

WHAT WE WILL DO

NABI will inspect and make repairs to the steering column support as needed.

NABI will contact you to schedule the inspection and repair of your vehicles.

NABI will repair the vehicles free of charge.

If NABI does not remedy this condition without charge on the mutually agreed upon service date or within 5 days of this agreed upon date, you can obtain assistance by calling NABI Customer Service at (256) 241-1298 or (256) 241-1312.
