IMPORTANT SAFETY RECALL

This notice applies to your vehicle, XXXXXXXXXXXXXXXXXXXX

Dear Hyundai Sonata Owner:

This notice is sent to you in accordance with the requirements of the National Traffic and Motor Vehicle Safety Act. Hyundai has decided that a defect which relates to motor vehicle safety exists in certain Model Year 2015 Hyundai Sonata vehicles produced beginning on April 25, 2014 through June 16, 2014. Our records indicate that your vehicle falls within this production date range.

What is the problem?

- An investigation by Hyundai discovered a manufacturing process error which may have affected the fatigue resistance of the front brake caliper's cast metal alloy. A fracture of the brake caliper assembly could result in a reduction in braking effectiveness and an increase in stopping distances, increasing the risk of a crash.

What will Hyundai do?

- Your Hyundai dealer will inspect the front brake caliper(s) on your vehicle and replace them if necessary. This procedure will be performed at no charge to you. The actual time required to perform the procedure should be less than 1 hour, however your vehicle may be needed longer depending on the dealer's schedule; therefore, we recommend scheduling a service appointment to minimize inconvenience.

What should you do?

- We urge you to call your Hyundai dealer to schedule an appointment to have this work performed as soon as possible.

What if you have other questions?
