Dear Peterbilt Customer,

This notice is sent to you in accordance with the requirements of the National Traffic and Motor Vehicle Safety Act.

Peterbilt Motors Company has decided that a defect which relates to motor vehicle safety exists in certain Model 210, 220 and 320 vehicles manufactured between March 14, 2012 and October 21, 2014, and are equipped with Eaton Power Distribution Centers (PDC). Your vehicle has been identified as having been manufactured within this time period and may contain a defect. In affected trucks, excessive play in electrical connections may cause one or more of the following: engine shutdown, loss of exterior lighting, loss of anti-lock braking system and/or loss of windshield wipers.

A safety hazard exists when power to critical functions is lost. This may result in loss of vehicle control, increasing the risk of a crash causing injury and or property damage.

<i>The problem is...</i>	Loss of connection to the Power Distribution Center
<i>Correction...</i>	Add mounting clips to secure Power Distribution Center electrical connections
<i>What you must do ...</i>	Contact your dealer immediately to schedule an appointment

Peterbilt has initiated a recall to remedy the defect free of charge. Please contact your nearest Peterbilt dealer. To find your nearest Peterbilt dealer, please visit Dealer Locator at www.Peterbilt.com. This repair should take up to 1.0 hours labor depending on model configuration, and will be performed at no charge to you. If you had this repair performed before you received this letter, you may be eligible to receive reimbursement for the cost of obtaining a pre-notification remedy of the problem associated with this recall.

This letter confirms the permanent solution is available, and supersedes any previous letter you may have received for an interim repair. Please contact your nearest Peterbilt dealer to have the permanent repair completed.
