**NHTSA RECALL # 14V-609  
INCORRECT GROSS AXLE WEIGHT RATING (GAWR) LABEL**

September 19, 2014

Dear Tiffin Motorhome Owner:

This notice is sent to you in accordance with the requirements of the National Traffic and Motor Vehicle Safety Act.

Tiffin Motorhomes has decided that a defect, which relates to motor vehicle safety, exists on the following models of motorhomes: 2013 36QSP, 40QBP and 45LP Allegro Buses; 2014 37AP, 40QBP, 40SP and 45LP Allegro Buses; 2015 37AP, 40SP AND 45LP Allegro Buses. The specific motorhomes have an incorrect front Gross Axle Weight Rating (GAWR) listed on the label that is attached to the entry door jamb. If the weight limit listed on the incorrect label was followed, the label would exceed the manufacturer's weight limit. Exceeding the manufacturer's weight limit could result in premature tire failure or reduced vehicle handling performance, either of which could increase the risk of a crash.

Tiffin Motorhomes has enclosed a new correct sticker in this letter and we are asking that the customer place the new correct sticker over the incorrect sticker. The location of the sticker is in the entry door jamb.

We have enclosed a form for you to complete and return to us when you have installed the new sticker in your motorhome. We have also enclosed an addressed and stamped envelope for your convenience.

If you do not own the vehicle that corresponds to the identification number which appears on the Recall Notification, please return the notification to the Tiffin Warranty Department with any information you can furnish that will assist us in locating the present owner.
