This notice is being sent to you in accordance with the requirements of the National Traffic and Motor Vehicle Safety Act. Based on the information received from Ricon, New England Wheels has decided that certain S-Series wheelchair lifts, produced by Ricon after January1, 2006 equipped with platforms measuring 32" x 51" and 34" x 54", can exhibit cracking of the platform pivot plate while in the stowed position which, if left unchecked, can propagate to the point where separation of the rear portion of the pivot plate occurs rendering the lift potentially inoperable creating a situation where injury could occur to the operator, occupant, or both.

Our records indicate that a Ricon wheelchair lift subject to this recall was installed in your vehicle(s) whose vehicle identification number(s) is/are:

What should you do?

Please contact John LaRose, Service Manager of New England Wheels immediately who will guide you through the inspection process and instruct you regarding any steps or actions required on your part to mitigate this recall. Your prompt attention to this matter is important.
