This notice is sent to you in accordance with the National Traffic and Motor Vehicle Safety Act.

General Motors has decided that certain 2015 model year Cadillac Escalade full size utility vehicles fail to conform to Federal Motor Vehicle Safety Standard No. 208, "Occupant Crash Protection". As a result, GM is conducting a recall. We apologize for this inconvenience. However, we are concerned about your safety and continued satisfaction with our products.

IMPORTANT

- This notice applies to your 2015 model year Cadillac Escalade, VIN:
- Your vehicle is involved in GM recall 14686.
- Schedule an appointment with your GM dealer.
- This service will be performed for you at **no charge**.

Why is your vehicle being recalled?

The passenger side instrument panel trim pad material on some of these vehicles is not constructed properly so that the instrument panel top pad material is incorrectly bonded with the vinyl skin. In this condition, the passenger side airbag may not deploy consistently in the forward position which will increase the potential for front passenger occupant injury during a vehicle crash when the airbag would deploy.

What will we do?

Your GM dealer will replace the instrument panel assembly. This service will be performed for you at **no charge**. Because of service scheduling requirements, it is likely that your dealer will need your vehicle longer than the actual service correction time of approximately 1 hour and 25 minutes.

What should you do?

You should contact your GM dealer to arrange a service appointment as soon as possible.
