Dear Valued Customer,

This notice is sent to you in accordance with the requirements of the National Traffic and Motor Vehicle Safety Act.

Spartan Motors Chassis, Inc. has decided a defect which relates to motor vehicle safety exists in certain emergency response chassis cabs.

Defect or Noncompliance:

The engine cooling fan is subject to vibration characteristics that exceed the material strength of the engine cooling fan. This could result the engine cooling fan coming apart a person is near the vicinity of the engine cooling fan, personal injury could occur. This could happen without warning.

Corrective Action:

Spartan Motors Chassis, Inc. will authorize to have the engine cooling fan replaced free of charge.

Labor Time:

The labor time required to perform said repairs may take 2 hours. Due to some service scheduling times, your service center may need your vehicle for a longer period.

What You Should Do:

Call Spartan Chassis at 1.800.543.5008. Steps will be taken to ensure the recall is performed at the nearest authorized service center. You may also find where facilities are located on Spartan's website: <http://www.spartanchassis.com>.

Leased Vehicles:



The lesser must notify the lessee by first class mail within ten (10) days from receipt of their owner notification letter from the manufacturer; both for the initial notification and all subsequent notifications.

Reimbursement:

If you had this repair performed before you received this letter, you may be eligible to receive reimbursement for the cost of obtaining a pre-notification remedy of the problem associated with this recall. For more information contact Spartan Chassis at 1.800.543.5008.
