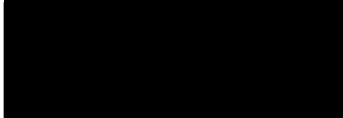
IMPORTANT SAFETY RECALL

Subject: Safety Recall 14KWN - Meritor Wabco QRDC Valve
NHTSA Recall number 14V-716



Dear Kenworth Customer,

This notice is sent to you in accordance with the requirements of the National Traffic and Motor Vehicle Safety Act.

Kenworth Truck Company has decided that a defect which relates to motor vehicle safety exists in certain model year 2015 Model K270 and K370 vehicles manufactured between February 4, 2014 and October 10, 2014 and are equipped with a quick-release with double-check (QRDC) valve. In affected trucks with a Meritor Wabco QRDC valves, used to control park/spring brake application, the valve may leak internally.

This could cause unintended partial or full park/spring brake application, which could affect service brake function and increase the risk of a crash. Also, dragging brakes could result in overheated components, increasing the risk of a fire. These issues could cause injury and/or damage to property.

<i>The problem is...</i>	Leaking QRDC valve.
<i>What your dealer will do...</i>	Dealers will remove and replace the QRDC valve.
<i>What you must do ...</i>	Contact your Kenworth Dealer to schedule an appointment for repair.

Kenworth has initiated a recall to replace the defective valve. Please contact your nearest Kenworth dealership to confirm parts are available before scheduling this repair. To find your nearest Kenworth dealer, please visit Dealer Locator at www.Kenworth.com. This repair should take approximately one hour and will be performed at no charge to you. If you had this repair performed before you received this letter, you may be eligible to receive reimbursement for the cost of obtaining a pre-notification remedy of the problem associated with this recall.

If you require further information about this recall, reimbursement of a pre-notification remedy associated with this recall or experience any difficulty in making arrangements for this repair, please contact: Kenworth Truck Company, P.O. If you no longer own this vehicle, we would appreciate your advising us of the new owner if you know their name. The enclosed card may be used for this purpose.

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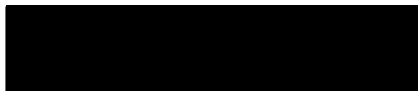
