Dear Kenworth Customer,

This notice is sent to you in accordance with the requirements of the National Traffic and Motor Vehicle Safety Act.

Kenworth Truck Company has decided that a defect, which relates to motor vehicle safety, exists in certain 2014 T660, T800, W900 and C500 vehicles manufactured between 09/19/2014 and 10/30/2014. These vehicles were manufactured with a trailer stop-lamp harness that does not meet Kenworth quality standards.

On T660, T800, W900 and C500 vehicles built during the time period indicated above, an undersized wire gauge was specified for the trailer stop-lamp circuit in the instrument panel harness. The smaller gauge wire is susceptible to thermal cycling which may result in damage to the wiring that could lead to a fire. In addition, the trailer stop-lamp fuse may fail more frequently, causing the trailer stop-lamps to be inoperable, which may increase the risk of a crash.

<i>The problem is...</i>	Undersized wire in the trailer stop-lamp circuit.
<i>What your dealer will do...</i>	Dealers will replace the undersized wiring with the correct specification.
<i>What you must do ...</i>	Contact your Kenworth Dealer to schedule an appointment for repair.

Kenworth has initiated a recall to replace the undersized wire with the correct sized wire. Please contact your Kenworth dealer immediately to schedule an appointment for this repair. To find your nearest Kenworth dealer, please visit Dealer Locator at www.Kenworth.com. This repair should take approximately two hours, and will be performed at no charge to you. If you had this repair performed before you received this letter, you may be eligible to receive reimbursement for the cost of obtaining a pre-notification remedy of the problem associated with this recall.

If you require further information about this recall, reimbursement of a pre-notification remedy associated with this recall or experience any difficulty in making arrangements for this repair, please contact: Kenworth Truck Company, P.O. If you no longer own this vehicle, we would appreciate your advising us of the new owner, if you know their name. The enclosed card may be used for this purpose.
