Dear Peterbilt Customer,

This notice is sent to you in accordance with the requirements of the National Traffic and Motor Vehicle Safety Act.

Peterbilt Motors Company has decided that a defect which relates to motor vehicle safety exists in certain Model 389 vehicles that were ordered with the Pride and Class option. Your vehicle has been identified as a Pride and Class vehicle. The steering wheel fastener nut may have been insufficiently tightened during vehicle assembly, or an incorrect nut may have been installed.

This could allow the steering wheel to become loose and slip in relation to the steering column shaft, increasing the risk of a crash causing injury and/or property damage.

The problem is...	Loose, incorrect or missing steering wheel nut
Correction...	Inspect and tighten or replace and install the steering wheel nut
What you must do ...	Contact your dealer immediately to schedule an appointment

Peterbilt has initiated a recall to remedy the defect free of charge. Parts are available from PACCAR Parts. To find your nearest Peterbilt dealer, please visit Dealer Locator at www.Peterbilt.com. This repair should take approximately 0.5 hours labor, and will be performed at no charge to you. If you had this repair performed before you received this letter, you may be eligible to receive reimbursement for the cost of obtaining a pre-notification remedy of the problem associated with this recall.
