IMPORTANT SAFETY RECALL 140016 (NHTSA RECALL NOTICE 14V-746)

This recall applies to your light tower trailer within the following Model(s) and Serial Numbers:

This notice is sent to you in accordance with the requirements of the National Traffic and Motor Vehicle Safety Act.

Terex has decided that a defect which relates to motor vehicle safety exists on our light tower model AL5 equipped with the 60 gallon fuel tank without the spill containment option.

The reason for this recall...

You are receiving this bulletin because you are the owner of an affected machine.

Terex has determined that insufficient structural support, for the lower section of the fuel tank installed in the light towers referenced above, can result in deformation of the fuel tank when filled with fuel. This can cause the fuel tank to make contact with the trailer axle. An impact between the fuel tank and trailer axle could produce a hole and fuel could leak. **If fuel reaches an ignition source it can result in a fire.**

What we are asking you to do....

Terex is asking customers and owners to add the "Fuel Tank Support Kit" on their affected machines.

- 1 Locate all light tower trailers within the model and serial ranges referenced above within your fleet.
- 2 Order "Fuel Tank Support Kit" PN 1259990 and install on your machine.

Note: Inspect the machine for any signs of a fuel leak. If a fuel leak is observed, the machine must be removed from service immediately and the fuel tank drained. Order the replacement tank (PN 162368) along with the fuel tank support kit and destroy the damaged fuel tank.

Installation of the kit must take place as soon as possible but no later than 30 days from receipt of the kit.

Continued Use Instructions:

All light tower trailer users and operators must be notified of these continued use requirements.

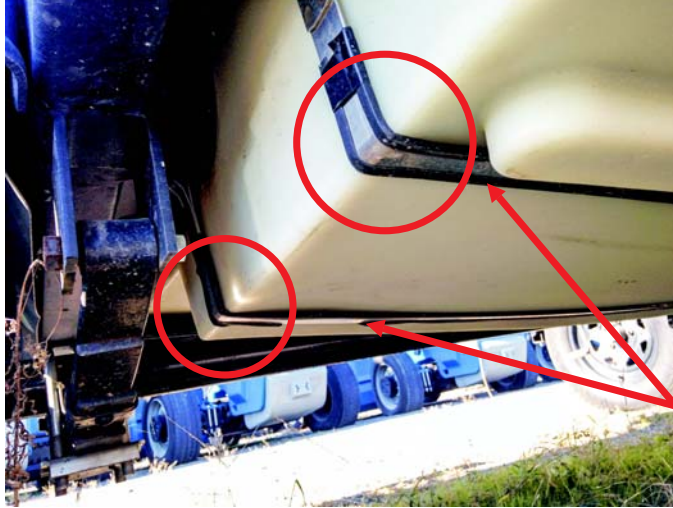
Do not tow the trailer if any of the following conditions is observed.

- Fuel tank is in constant contact with the axle.
- Fuel tank is sagging in such a way that it intermittently contacts the axle during towing.

The light tower can still be used in a stationary position if no fuel leak is observed.



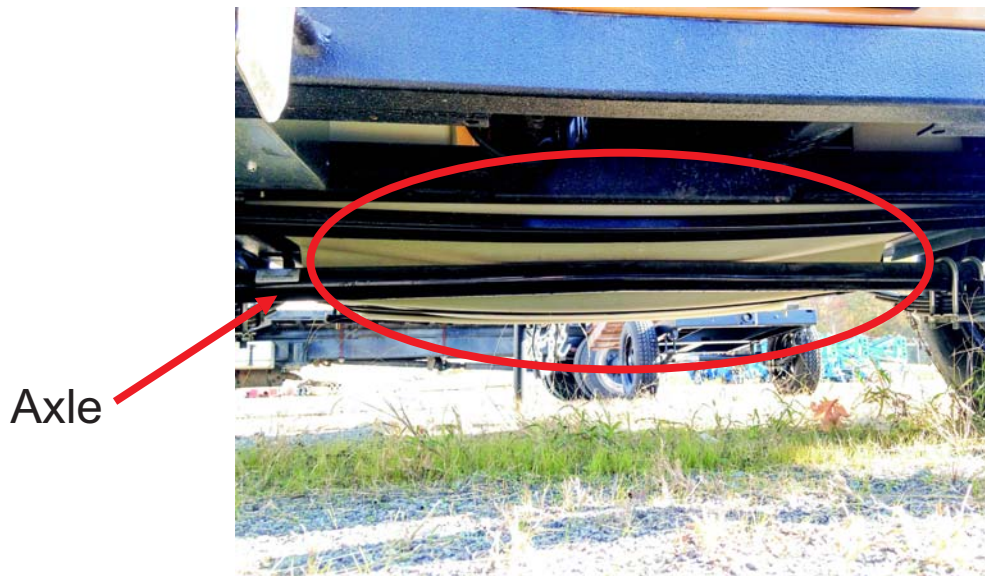
If the fuel tank strap has permanently deformed the tank by 0.25 inches at the bottom corner of the tank, the tank should be replaced (refer to Photo 1). Order the replacement tank (PN 162368) along with the fuel tank support kit and destroy the damaged fuel tank.

If deformation is observed at the belly of the fuel tank (refer to Photo 2), the fuel tank does not have to be replaced. The kit will support the tank.
