# IMPORTANT SAFETY RECALL

## Dear Hyundai Sonata Owner:

This notice is sent to you in accordance with the requirements of the National Traffic and Motor Vehicle Safety Act. Hyundai has decided that a defect which relates to motor vehicle safety exists in certain Model Year 2015 1.6 liter Hyundai Sonata vehicles produced beginning on August 29, 2014 through October 28, 2014. You received this notice because our records, which are based primarily on state registration and title data, indicate that you are the current owner.

# What is the problem?

The incorrect left axle shaft may have been installed during vehicle assembly. As a result, the left axle shaft may separate from the transaxle's differential. If the left axle shaft separates from the transaxle, the vehicle may stop moving, increasing the risk of a crash. Additionally, a separated axle shaft may allow the vehicle to roll away as the driver and other occupants exit the vehicle or anytime thereafter (without a fully applied parking brake). A vehicle rollaway increases the risk of injury to exiting occupants and bystanders.

#### What will Hyundai do?

Your Hyundai dealer will inspect and if necessary, replace the axle shaft. This procedure
will be performed at no charge to you. The actual time required to perform the procedure
should be less than 1 hour, however your vehicle may be needed longer depending on the
dealer's schedule; therefore, we recommend scheduling a service appointment to minimize
inconvenience.

### What should you do?

• We urge you to call your Hyundai dealer to schedule an appointment to have this work performed as soon as possible.
