Dear Terex Advance Owner,

This notice is sent to you in accordance with the requirements of the National Traffic and Motor Vehicle Safety Act.

**REASON FOR RECALL**

Terex has decided that a defect which relates to motor vehicle safety exists in certain model year 2013-2015 Front Discharge Concrete Mixer Trucks, manufactured August 20, 2012, to December 5, 2014. Due to improperly secured castellated retaining nuts on the front axle leaf spring rear pin and the steering system linkage, the rear end of the front axle leaf spring may partially disconnect from the front suspension hanger or the steering system linkage may loosen. **If this occurs, steering difficulty may result, increasing the risk of a crash.**

**WHAT TEREX WILL DO**

Terex will provide a document entitled "Inspection Points for Recall 14V-793," which is included in this mailing, to all potentially affected unit owners. Owners are then asked to have their maintenance department personnel use this document to guide them in inspecting the points in question, and verify that the cotter pins are installed in the castellated nuts, and both legs of the cotter pin are bent. If a fastener issue is reported / identified, replacement hardware will be provided free of charge, along with detailed installation instructions. Owners will also be reimbursed for labor related to required fastener replacement.

**WHAT YOU SHOULD DO**

Immediately inspect the castellated nut fasteners as indicated in attached Safety Notice 14V-793.
