New Safety Recall Advanced Communication – P65100614

Chrysler Group LLC (Chrysler) announced a safety recall on certain 2010 through 2014 model year:

- (DC) RAM 3500 Cab Chassis (2010 model year only)
- (DD) RAM 3500 Cab Chassis (2011 through 2014 model years)
- (DJ) RAM 2500 Pick-Up Truck (2010 through 2014 model years)
- (DM) RAM 4500/5500 Cab Chassis (2010 model year only)
- (DP) RAM 4500/5500 Cab Chassis (2011 through 2014 model years)
- (DX) RAM Truck Mexico (2010 through 2014 model years)
- (D2) RAM 3500 Pick-Up Truck (2010 through 2014 model years)

All of the above vehicles are equipped with a 6.7L Cummins Turbo Diesel engine (sales code ETJ or ETK).

Some of the above vehicles may experience a fuel leak at the fuel heater electrical connection. The fuel heater housing may deform and overheat, leading to the failure of an O-ring that seals the male terminals in the fuel heater assembly. A leaking fuel heater could cause underhood smoke and/or an engine compartment fire.

Chrysler will conduct a voluntary safety recall on all involved vehicles. The diesel fuel heater housing must be inspected for fuel leaks. If a fuel leak is found, the diesel fuel heater/water separator assembly must be replaced. Also, the diesel fuel heater wire harness electrical connector must be replaced on all vehicles.

Dealers will be notified of the launch of this safety recall by way of established methods used in the past.
