Chrysler Group LLC (Chrysler) announced a safety recall on certain 2006 model year:

(ND) Dodge Dakota trucks

(DR) Ram 1500 series pick-up trucks

(DH) RAM 2500/3500 series pick-up trucks

(D1) RAM 3500 series pick-up trucks

(DX) RAM trucks (Mexico)

that is equipped with a manual transmission.

The above vehicles were built with a clutch interlock switch that contains a return spring that may fatigue. A fatigued clutch interlock switch return spring could allow the driver to engage the engine's starter motor without the clutch pedal being depressed. Engaging the engine's starter motor, with the transmission in gear and the clutch engaged, could result in unintended vehicle movement and cause a crash without warning.

Chrysler will conduct a voluntary safety recall on all affected vehicles to replace the clutch interlock switch on all affected vehicles.

Dealers will be notified of the launch of this safety recall by way of established methods used in the past.

We ask that you please take the time to ensure that your personnel are aware of this communication and are prepared to execute a customer friendly process for inquiries on involved vehicles.
