AE04 - Replacing Upper Part of Lock on Front Lid (Recall Campaign)

Model Line:	911 (991)					
Model Year:	As of 2014 up to 2015					
Concerns:	Upper part of lock on front lid					
Information:	This is to inform you of a Recall Campaign on the above-mentioned vehicles. Due to a temporary manufacturing error, there is a possibility that front lid lock upper parts, on which the catch bar was not riveted to the mounting plate according to specifications, were installed on the affected vehicles.					
	The durability of the upper part of the lock cannot be guaranteed over the service life of the affected vehicles and the risk of the lid opening unintentionally cannot be ruled out.					
Action Required:	Replace upper part of lock on front lid.					
Affected Vehicles:	The VIN(s) can be checked by using PIWIS Vehicle Information link to verify if the campaign affects the vehicle. This campaign is scope specific to the VIN! Failure to verify in PIWIS may result in an improper repair. This campaign affects 1,492 vehicles in North America.					
Tools:	Torque wrench, e.g. V.A.G 1331 - Torque wrench, 6-50 Nm (4.5-37 ftlb.)					
Parts Info:	NOTE: An initial automatic parts allocation will be initiated on November 11, 2014. A second automatic parts allocation will be undertaken when additional parts arrive in the U.S. NO PTEC/PAV REQUESTS FOR PARTS WILL BE HONORED BEFORE THE SECOND ALLOCATION IS COMPLETED.
