Dear Peterbilt Customer,

This notice is sent to you in accordance with the requirements of the National Traffic and Motor Vehicle Safety Act.

Peterbilt Motors Company has decided that certain Peterbilt vehicles manufactured between October 6, 2007 and September 23, 2013 fail to conform to the FMVSS No. 121, (Air Brake Systems). Your vehicle has been identified as having been manufactured within this time period and may contain a noncompliance. The ES-420 brake linings used on the front brakes are not rated for GAWR between 20,001 and 22,000 lbs when used with larger SLR (20.5 inches to 21.5 inches) tires.

The incorrect brake linings were used with 16.5 X 7 front drum brakes on vehicles equipped with front axles rated between 20,001 and 22,000 lbs GAWR. Inadequate braking could lengthen stopping distances needed to stop the vehicle and increase the risk of a crash.

The problem is...	Front brakes do not meet federal standards
Correction...	Replace with the correct brake linings
What you must do ...	Contact your dealer immediately to schedule an appointment

Peterbilt has initiated a recall to replace the brake linings in your truck. To find your nearest Peterbilt dealer, please visit Dealer Locator at www.Peterbilt.com. This repair should take approximately 3 hours, and will be performed at no charge to you. If you had this repair performed before you received this letter, you may be eligible to receive reimbursement for the cost of obtaining a pre-notification remedy of the problem associated with this recall.


