IMPORTANT SAFETY RECALL NOTICE RE-NOTIFICATION

This notice applies to your vehicle identified by both Blue Bird body number and Vehicle Identification Number (VIN) on the enclosed yellow coversheet.

Dear Blue Bird Owner:

This notice is sent to you in accordance with the requirements of the National Traffic and Motor Vehicle Safety Act.

Blue Bird Body Company has decided that a defect which relates to motor vehicle safety exists in certain 2013 through 2015 model year Blue Bird "Vision" model school buses and non-school buses manufactured from December 05, 2011 through July 02, 2014 and equipped with propane autogas fuel systems.

Blue Bird had determined that the propane autogas fuel system fuel return line can fatigue which could lead to a crack in the fuel line near the support bracket. This failure may result in possible leakage of propane autogas, which could potentially lead to fire. To remedy this condition the existing propane fuel return line was to be replaced and a new fuel return line with support clamps installed.

Owners were originally notified about the issued Recall R14XJ on September 29, 2014. Roush CleanTech, LLC assembled field service teams that were expedited to your location to perform the recall remedy at no cost to you.

Roush personnel have completed inspections and necessary repairs on over 80% of the buses identified. **However, it has been brought to our attention that some of the completed buses may require a re-inspection.**

This letter is to advise you that your buses affected by Recall R14XJ have been identified as needing to be re-inspected. Roush personnel will be contacting you again shortly to perform the re-inspection and, if necessary, further repairs on your buses. If further repairs are needed the process is expected to take 45 minutes per bus to complete.

If you are the lessor of this vehicle, please forward a copy of this notice to the lessee within ten days to comply with federal regulations.
