This letter serves to acknowledge DS Corp DBA Crossroads RV's notification to the National Highway Traffic Safety Administration (NHTSA) of a safety recall which will be conducted pursuant to Federal law for the product(s) listed below. Problem Description:

DS Corp DBA Crossroads RV (Crossroads) is recalling certain model year 2015-2016 Sunset Trail trailers manufactured November 14, 2014, to September 1, 2015. The affected trailers are equipped with kitchen ranges that were installed without a panel to isolate the range from air movement.

Consequence:

Without the required isolation panel, a back draft may occur from the top burner increasing the risk of a potential explosion, fire or carbon monoxide build up.

Remedy:

Crossroads has notified owners, and dealers will install the panel to prevent air movement affecting the kitchen range, free of charge. The recall began on September 22, 2015. Owners may contact Crossroads at 1-855-226-7496 or by email at service@crossroadsrv.com. Crossroads' number for this recall is 38.

Please be reminded of the following requirements:

Copies of all notices, bulletins, dealer notifications, and other communications that relate to this recall are required to be submitted to this office no later than 5 days after they are originally sent (if they are sent to more than one manufacturer, distributor, dealer, or purchaser/owner).

Please be reminded that under 49 U.S.C. § 30112(a)(3), it is illegal for a manufacturer, to sell, offer for sale, import, or introduce or deliver into interstate commerce, a motor vehicle or item of motor vehicle equipment that contains a safety defect once the manufacturer has notified NHTSA about that safety defect. This prohibition does not apply once the motor vehicle or motor vehicle equipment has been remedied according to the manufacturer's instructions.

As stated in Part 573.7, submission of the first of six consecutive quarterly status reports is required within one month after the close of the calendar quarter in which notification to purchasers occurs. Therefore, the first quarterly report will be due on, or before, 30 days after the close of the calendar quarter.
