In December 2015 our Sales department receive a letter from NHTSA and then in January 2016 Life Line's owner received an email from NHTSA referring to EQ investigation EQ 14-015. Working with NHTSA Life Line issued a recall and letters went out to the customers on February 2, 2016. Liquid Springs has confirmed that the repairs have been made. February 19, 2016 Michelle Rice (NHTSA) requested a letter from Liquid Spring be added to the "Owner Notification" portion of the upload. I confirmed, via email, that this was completed on February 20, 2016.
