Description of the Defect : General Motors has decided that certain 2015 Model Year Chevrolet Traverse, GMC Acadia and Buick Enclave vehicles fail to conform to Federal Motor Vehicle Safety Standard (FMVSS) No. 110, Paragraph 4.1 "Tire Selection and Rims", which requires such vehicles to be equipped with tires that meet the requirements of FMVSS No. 139, Paragraph 6.3.2 "New Pneumatic Radial Tires for Light Vehicles". Goodyear Tire & Rubber Company (Goodyear), has informed GM that certain P255/65R18 Fortera HL tires sold by Goodyear to GM and installed on such vehicles fail to conform to FMVSS 139. Goodyear has filed a separate notice of noncompliance under 49 CFR part 573 that provides further detail (15T002).

Description of the Safety Risk : General Motors has decided that certain 2015 Model Year Chevrolet Traverse, GMC Acadia and Buick Enclave vehicles fail to conform to Federal Motor Vehicle Safety Standard (FMVSS) No. 110, Paragraph 4.1 "Tire Selection and Rims", which requires such vehicles to be equipped with tires that meet the requirements of FMVSS No. 139, Paragraph 6.3.2 "New Pneumatic Radial Tires for Light Vehicles". Goodyear Tire & Rubber Company (Goodyear), has informed GM that certain P255/65R18 Fortera HL tires sold by Goodyear to GM and installed on such vehicles fail to conform to FMVSS 139. Goodyear has filed a separate notice of noncompliance under 49 CFR part 573 that provides further detail (15T002).

Description of the Cause : Goodyear has indicated that its analysis of the cause is ongoing.

Identification of Any Warning that can Occur : According to Goodyear, this is a test-induced noncompliance; however, in the event that this condition would manifest itself in tires in service, tread chunking, noise, or vibration may occur. See Goodyear's part 573 submission for more information.

Chronology :

On January 12, 2015, Goodyear notified GM that during routine FMVSS 139 testing of one of its P255/65R18 Fortera HL tires Goodyear identified a tread crack with no loss of air in the crown area of the tire. Goodyear indicated that it was running additional tire testing to confirm the crack condition.

On January 14, 2015, Goodyear notified GM it had confirmed the crack condition after completing testing of additional tires. GM then placed a shipping hold on potentially affected vehicles pending Goodyear's decision related to FMVSS compliance of the subject tires

On January 15, 2015, GM held an emergency meeting of its Safety and Field Action Decision Authority (SFADA), which reviewed the potential noncompliance with FMVSS 139 and FMVSS 110.

On January 16, 2015, Goodyear informed General Motors of its decision that a noncompliance to FMVSS 139 exists for the subject tires produced during a certain date range, and concurrently GM's SFADA decided that a noncompliance to FMVSS 110 exists for the vehicles on which these tires were installed.

Description of Remedy :

Description of Remedy Program : All tires identified within the DOT date range beginning 4814 through 0115 will be replaced with conforming tires at no charge to the customer/ consumer.

Pursuant to 577.11, General Motors does not plan to provide notice about reimbursement to owners because all involved vehicles are covered under the new vehicle warranty.

Description of Recall Schedule : General Motors will release recall 15025 for involved production vehicles and recall 15067 for dealer replaced tires. General Motors has not yet identified the tire population for dealer replacement. General Motors sent the dealer bulletin for 15025 on January 26, 2015, and will provide bulletin 15067 and owner letter mail dates for both when available. General Motors sent a stop delivery message to dealers on January 16, 2015.
