Description of the Safety Risk : If the fastening bolts back out completely, the parking brake bracket will separate, causing the parking brake to fail and increasing the risk of a roll-away accident. Description of the Cause : The assembly process to fasten the parking brake brackets was moved within the

plant on February 4, 2015, which resulted in the use of a different, two-step fastening process. The operator of the fastening tools may have failed to perform the second step. This error was not identified during the assembly process because the fastening tool did not incorporate error-testing for this operation.

## **Chronology**:

On February 9, 2015, an inspection at GM's Lordstown assembly plant found that the left rear parking brake bracket in a 2015 model year Chevrolet Cruze vehicle had not been properly fastened. Two of the three fastening bolts in the parking brake bracket were not torqued to the correct specification.

On February 11, 2015, GM determined that, if all three fastening bolts in the parking brake bracket were to back out completely, the parking brake may not conform to S7 of FMVSS No. 135.

On February 16, 2015, GM's Safety and Field Action Decision Authority (SFADA) decided to conduct a non-compliance recall.

## **Description of Remedy :**

Description of Remedy Program : Dealers will Inspect the left-rear and right-rear parking brake bracket bolts and, if necessary, tighten to the correct torque specification. Pursuant to 577.11, General Motors does not plan to provide notice about reimbursement to owners because all involved vehicles are covered under the new vehicle warranty.
