Description of the Defect : Kawasaki is recalling certain model year 2009-2013 Concours 14 police motorcycles. The additional police accessories may cause the 30-amp fuse to blow. Also, the additional police wiring harness may chafe leading to a short, which may blow the main fuse.

Description of the Safety Risk : If the fuse blows the engine may stall increasing the risk of a crash.

Description of the Cause : The modifications and reconfiguration of the electrical system by Enforcement Motors, Beaudry or BMS could cause an electrical overload on the charging circuit between the regulator and the two batteries.

Identification of Any Warning that can Occur : Loss of electrical current necessary for the operation of the motorcycle, including a loss of engine power.

The chronology included in the defect report submitted in safety recall campaign 12V-134 provides the basis upon which KMC determined in March 2012 that the equipment installed by Enforcement Motors, Beaudry and BMS contained safety related defects and that a recall was necessary.
