Description of the Defect: Updated December 7, 2018: This submission is to inform the Agency of Ford's intent to implement the "Other" report category for removed vehicles in Quarterly Reporting as permitted in the Third Amendment to the Coordinated Remedy Order (ACRO3), paragraphs 45 through 49. As a condition of ACRO3, all affected vehicles will remain active, or "live," across Ford's data systems such that any search of "Other" removed VINs will return an open recall status. For this reason, the number of potential involved vehicles in this report will remain the same. However, for reference, initial counts of vehicles in the "Other" reporting category are indicated in the attached supplement. Note that these counts are current as of fourth calendar quarter of 2018. Future changes to overall Total Removed counts, including "Other" will be reflected in quarterly reporting.

> Update: On May 3, 2016, final repair driver airbag service parts became available for dealers to order. As a result, Recall 15V-319 supersedes Recall 14V-802.

On May 18, 2015, Takata submitted a Defect Information Report (DIR) to

PSDI-4 driver side airbag inflators. PSDI-4 driver side inflators were installed on Ford Mustang and Ford GT vehicles. Takata's DIR expands the prior recall vehicle population to all 2005-2014 Mustang and all 2005-2006 GT vehicles equipped with PSDI-4 inflators.

Ford is aware of one report of an injury on a 2007 Ford Mustang related to this condition.

Description of the Safety Risk: As described by Takata in its Part 573 report, the Takata PSDI-4 driver side

inflator could rupture if the vehicle is involved in a crash where the

supplemental frontal airbags are designed to deploy. If this occurs, it may

increase the risk of injury to the occupants.

Chronology:

On May 3, 2016, final repair driver airbag service parts became available for dealers to order. Ford has superseded the interim repair recall with the final repair.

On May 18, 2015, Takata submitted a DIR to NHTSA regarding the PSDI-4 driver airbag inflator. Ford evaluated the information contained in Takata's DIR and potential effects on Ford vehicles.

On May 26, 2015, Ford's Field Review Committee reviewed the concern and approved a field action.

On September 3, 2015, NHTSA requested that Ford update the "Number of Potentially Involved Vehicles" to reflect the number of vehicles determined to be in service using current registration information and is provided to the Agency in Ford's Takata Dashboard submitted on August 28, 2015.

August 9, 2024: This amendment updates the remedy to issue a DO NOT DRIVE advisory for remaining unrepaired vehicles.

Description of Remedy:

Description of Remedy Program: Owners will be notified by mail and instructed to take their vehicle to a

Ford or Lincoln dealer to have their driver side airbag inflator replaced.

There will be no charge for this service.

Ford is excluding reimbursement for costs because the original warranty

program would provide for a free repair for this concern.

On August 9, 2024, to further urge owners to have their vehicle repaired for the subject safety recall, Ford is issuing a DO NOT DRIVE advisory for the vehicles involved in this recall that remain unrepaired. Re-notification owner letters will be mailed according to the provided recall schedule.

Ford will forward a copy of the notification letters to dealers to the agency

when available.
