Description of the Defect:

A concern has been identified on 2016MY F-TYPE vehicles where the electric power steering system may still be set in the supplier's factory operating mode. In this condition, where another defect arises with the electric power steering system, the system will inappropriately operate.

In certain circumstances, the vehicle may experience additional unexpected steering inputs from the electric power steering system. These additional system generated steering inputs may exceed the ability of a normal driver to control the consequences.

Chronology:

The issue was initially identified in February 2015 during the launch phase of 2016MY F-TYPE program. At this time, all vehicles were under the manufacturers control and markets were instructed not to release vehicles until revised software was installed by the component supplier. Ongoing reviews of completion of these repairs revealed, in August 2015, a number of vehicles remained unrepaired and were potentially now outside of the control of the manufacturer. This matter was brought to the attention of the Jaguar Land Rover Product Safety and Compliance Committee.

The issue was reviewed at Jaguar Land Rover's Product Safety and Compliance Committee (PSCC) on August 18, 2015, where engineering identified a number of vehicles which had the electric power steering system set in factory mode. A stop shipment was issued to restrict vehicle distribution of the 54 vehicles identified with this condition.

Jaguar Land Rover engineering and the component suppliers recognized that vehicles in this condition would operate as normal if no other failure mode was present. If the vehicle then developed a software fault with the steering system, the vehicle may unexpectedly, because the electric power steering system is in factory set mode, experience a steering input force to the steering wheel the driver may not be able to control. The PSCC concluded that this issue should be progressed to the Jaguar Land Rover Senior Review Panel (SRP).

The SRP reviewed all information on September 3, 2015 and concluded that as there is a possibility that vehicles are now outside of the manufacturers control and that the concern represents an unreasonable risk to safety. A voluntarily safety recall was requested to be conducted.

There have been no reported accidents and or injuries as a result of this concern.

Description of Recall Schedule : Owners will be instructed to present their vehicle to an approved Jaguar

dealer. The Dealer will make arrangements for the component supplier to inspect the electric power steering system software version. If the system is still in the supplier's factory mode the correct software will be downloaded.

Alternatively, where the vehicle is not accessible to the supplier due to logistical reasons, the steering rack will be replaced by the dealer with a steering rack which is to the correct specification.

There will be no charge to owners for this procedure.
