Description of the Noncompliance : The vehicles do not to comply with the requirements of CFR 49 Part 567.4 (g) (iii) (3) and (4). More specifically, the Certification label is missing the Gross Vehicle Weight Rating (GVWR) and Gross Axle Weight Rating (GAWR) information.
