We have revised the Criteria 03 repair instructions and SAGA claiming information for Safety Recall 24AP. This information will be published in Elsa and in ServiceNet on March 17, 2015. Please ensure that everyone in your dealership – including Parts and Service personnel – are made aware of this important revision.

Additionally, on March 17, 2015, customer notifications will begin. Because federal regulations require information on open recalls to be displayed in the audiusa.com and NHTSA VIN search tools, on that date vehicles affected by safety recall code **24AP** will show in these VIN search tools and in Elsa as “Repair Needed.”
