New Safety Recall Advanced Communication – R06012815

FCA US LLC (Chrysler) announced a safety recall on:

- 2002 and 2003 model year (KJ) Jeep Liberty vehicles built through March 28, 2003.
- 2002 through 2004 model year (WJ) Jeep Grand Cherokee vehicles built through May 23, 2003.
- All 2003 and 2004 model year (ZB) Dodge Viper vehicles.

The above vehicles may experience a front airbag, side curtain airbag, and/or seatbelt pretensioner inadvertent deployment.

NOTE: KJ and WJ vehicles were previously involved in Safety Recall M35 and ZB vehicles were involved in Safety Recall N13. Vehicles in for service with Recall M35 or N13 “OPEN” should still have those recalls performed.

Chrysler will conduct a voluntary safety recall on all affected vehicles to replace the Occupant Restraint Control (ORC) module and front and/or side impact sensors as required. Vehicles that did not have Safety Recall M35 or N13 performed will also have an in-line diode filter jumper harness installed.

Dealers will be notified of the launch of this recall by way of established methods used in the past.

We ask that you please take the time to ensure that your personnel are aware of this communication and are prepared to execute a customer friendly process for inquiries on involved vehicles.
