**Summary:**

**Description of Defect:**

The volume of air that can be stored in the air reservoirs is lower than the requirement as stated in S5.1.2 Reservoirs of FMVSS121, Air Brakes. The trucks as configured require 96 liters, but only 88 liters are available from the tanks fitted to the trucks.

Mack Trucks has received no reports of crashes as a result of this condition. Therefore, Mack considers this as a proactive measure to protect the public and Mack's customers from the potential risk associated with this non-compliance.

**Models/ Model Years Affected:**

Mack: Certain 2014 and 2015 Pinnacle (CXU) model trucks manufactured from June 1, 2013 through November 28, 2014

**Vehicle Quantities:**

Mack: 96 Trucks (85 U.S., 10 Canada, 1 Export)

**Dealer's Responsibility:**

The National Traffic and Motor Vehicle Safety Act and Canadian Motor Vehicle Safety Act requires dealers to ensure that all new and used vehicles are free of safety defects and comply with all relevant safety standards at the time of delivery to the consumer.

Dealers should make their personnel aware of the safety recall. In the event that a dealer has a vehicle included in the safety recall in their inventory to be sold, the condition must be corrected before releasing it to a customer.

**Release Schedule:**

- Vehicle will be posted on the Trucks Dealer Portal February 6, 2015.
- Repair Instructions are tentatively scheduled for release no later than March 26, 2015.
- Owner Notices are scheduled to be mailed on or before March 26, 2015.
