******* Dealer Announcement*******

The purpose of this announcement is to provide a parts status update to dealers, as promised in our campaign bulletin update on May 29th.

******* Parts Update*******

Nissan has been able to meet current demands for vehicles that are inoperable and/or have customers in rentals. Nissan will continue to prioritize orders for customers with vehicles off-road.

At this time, Nissan's oldest backorder for non-priority orders is dated May 27th, 2015. Nissan anticipates reducing backorder wait times to 1 week by the end of June.

******* Invitation to Repair Timing*******

Nissan expects to mail repair notifications to customers affected by PC368 the week of July 27th. Nissan anticipates mailing invitations to repair for customers affected by PC369 & 370 after September as originally communicated.

******* What Dealers Should Do*******

1. Please continue to advise customers to wait for their invitation to repair notification if their vehicle is operational.
 - Remind customers if their vehicle should become inoperable prior to repair, complimentary towing is available by dialing 1-866-821-4145.
2. Please continue using the order form to order parts via campaign.parts@nissan-usa.com.
 - Parts will be prioritized towards vehicles that are inoperable and/or have customers in rentals.
