## 2014 Rogue (T32) Fuel Pump Voluntary Safety Recall Campaign

### **A STOP SALE CONDITION IS IN EFFECT.**

On April 14, Nissan informed dealers that the population of vehicles originally announced under PC365 was being revised. To accommodate this revision, Nissan advised that SERVICE COMM would be turned off for PC365, and three new campaign IDs (PC368, PC369, PC370) would be issued for this recall campaign. All three of the new campaign IDs are now active in SERVICE COMM.

**IMPORTANT: It is a violation of Federal law for dealers to sell or deliver vehicles in their inventory covered by this notification until the campaign action is performed.**

\*\*\*\*\* What Dealers Should Do \*\*\*\*\*

1. Verify if vehicles are affected by this Voluntary Safety Recall Campaign using SERVICE COMM I.D. PC368, PC369, or PC370.
2. **Any 2014 Rogue vehicles that are not included in PC368, PC369, or PC370 via SERVICE COMM may be released for sale at this time.**

\*\*\*\*\* Vehicle Identification \*\*\*\*\*

Approximately **12** vehicles are currently in dealer inventory. Vehicles subject to this action can be identified through:

- **SERVICE COMM** – Service departments can complete an inquiry in SERVICE COMM – **I.D. PC368, PC369, PC370** – to determine if a vehicle is subject to this voluntary safety recall.
- **VIN List** – As a courtesy, included with this announcement is a list of affected vehicles sorted by region, district, and dealer.
