Subject: Upcoming Safety Recall 8515G – 2007-2014 CX-9 Lower Control Arms

On July 16, 2015, Mazda Motor Corporation filed a safety defect report with the National Highway Traffic Safety Administration (NHTSA) to address a concern with 2007-2014 CX-9 vehicles produced from October 24, 2006 through December 28, 2013. Mazda has assigned recall number 8515G to this campaign.

On the affected vehicles, it is possible that water may enter the front suspension ball joint fitting. Driving on roadways during the winter months can lead to saltwater intrusion into the ball joint, causing corrosion, which can result in looseness of the ball joint in the fitting. As a result of the looseness, a rattle may occur at the lower control arm ball joint. After extended operation in this condition, in the worst case the ball joint and lower control arm may separate.

Action Required:

Beginning today, subject vehicles in the above build date range in dealer inventory must not be delivered to customers until the recall repair is completed. Please confirm the production dates for all CX-9s in your inventory.
