Affected vehicles are identified in OASIS and FSA VIN lists.

REASON FOR THIS COMPLIANCE RECALL

All of the affected vehicles may not conform to the requirements specified by Federal Motor Vehicle Safety Standard (FMVSS) 210, seat belt anchorage. The front passenger and center seat belts may not be anchored in the correct position relative to the seat, increasing the risk of injury in a crash.

SERVICE ACTION

A complete Dealer Bulletin will be provided to dealers when repair instructions and parts ordering information becomes available to support this compliance recall.

OWNER NOTIFICATION MAILING SCHEDULE

Owners of record will be notified via first-class mail after repair instructions and parts ordering information are provided to dealers.

PLEASE NOTE:

Federal law requires dealers to complete this recall service before a new vehicle is delivered to the buyer or lessee. Violation of this requirement by a dealer could result in a civil penalty of up to \$7,000 per vehicle. Correct all vehicles in your new vehicle inventory before delivery.
