Subject: Upcoming Safety Recall Affecting Certain 2014 - 2015 MY Lancer Ralliart and Lancer Evolution – Right Parking Brake Cable Interference with Fuel Tank (SR-15-009)

On August 28, 2015, MMNA submitted to the National Highway Traffic Safety Administration (NHTSA) a Defect Information Report regarding certain 2014 – 2015 Lancer Ralliart and Lancer Evolution vehicles built January 31, 2014 to September 5, 2014. Due to an improper installation of the right parking brake cable during production, the cable may have insufficient clearance with the fuel tank, causing abrasive contact between the two components. The coating on the fuel tank could deteriorate from this abrasive contact and potentially allow for rust formation. In the worst case scenario, a pin hole could develop and allow for fuel leakage.

MMNA is preparing to launch this safety recall campaign, and you will receive a formal/official dealer notification when this campaign is launched. You are receiving this advance, informal letter because:

1. NHTSA will announce the recall on their website shortly after receipt of our Defect Information Report, and MMNA wants to assist you in handling any customer inquiries you may receive regarding this recall.
