Attention: All Kia Parts & Service Managers

Kia Motors America, Inc. pursuant to the National Traffic and Motor Vehicle Safety Act is conducting a Voluntary Safety Recall Campaign to replace the brake-shift interlock mechanism on certain 2011-2013 MY Sorento vehicles produced from October 19, 2009 through January 31, 2013 and equipped with an automatic transmission. Section S5.3 of Federal Motor Vehicle Safety Standard 114 requires the service brake to be depressed before the transmission can be shifted out of PARK. When excessive force is applied to the gear shift lever, the park position catch in the brake-shift interlock mechanism can chip or crack. Once sufficient damage occurs to the park position catch, it is possible for the shift lever to be moved out of PARK without the brake pedal being depressed. If this occurs, the vehicle can roll, increasing the risk of a crash and/or injury, especially if a driver is not present.

The Technical Service Bulletin (TSB) that provides Vehicle Repair Procedures, Affected VIN Production Range, and Warranty Claim Information will be posted on the Kia Global Information System (KGIS) at www.kiatechinfo.com on **November 5, 2015**.

During the week of November 2, 2015, all Kia dealers will receive an initial shipment of campaign parts for initial repairs of affected customer vehicles.

Enclosed you will find a copy of the owner notification letter and a Q&A Guide for recall questions, both of which describe the issue. A list of retailed Kia Sorento owners affected by this recall can be accessed on WEBDCS. Log onto the site, select the Consumer Affairs Tab, click on Not Completed Recall VINS in the left side menu, and select **SC124** to generate the list.

We will mail notices to the affected 2011-2013 MY Sorento vehicle owners beginning on **November 9, 2015**. Please start performing the repairs immediately on any affected vehicles currently in your inventory.

Also, please make certain the appropriate personnel in your dealership are familiar with the details of this recall to ensure proper responses to customer inquiries and requests to have the recall performed on their 2011-2013 MY Sorento vehicles. This Voluntary Safety Recall represents an opportunity for your service department to deliver an exceptional service experience (e.g. flexible service appointment process, car wash and vacuum and timely service).

NHTSA ADVISORY: It is a violation of Federal law for a dealer to deliver a new motor vehicle covered by this notification under a sale or lease until the defect is remedied.

LEGAL PRIVACY LIABILITY NOTICE: Pursuant to the terms of the Dealer Sales and Service Agreement and the Gramm-Leach-Bliley federal consumer privacy act, you are required to keep confidential any and all information and documents provided to you by Kia Motors America, Inc. or generated by you in the conduct of carrying out work under that Agreement regarding Kia vehicle purchasers and owners, including but not limited to warranty claim information. Kia dealers may use such owner information for the sole purpose of conducting and performing this voluntary safety recall campaign, and for no other purpose.
