This Safety Recall Notice was sent to customers in accordance with the requirements of the National Traffic and Motor Vehicle Safety Act.

Reason for This Recall

Eldorado National California, Inc. ("Eldorado") decided that a defect which relates to motor vehicle safety exists in certain Eldorado National Passport model buses manufactured between August 1, 2009 and June 30, 2010. Other bus models manufactured by Eldorado are not included in this recall.

Vehicles subject to this recall campaign were manufactured with a defective electric door opener PC board manufactured by A&M Systems, Inc., between August 1, 2009 and March 31, 2010. A single model of a PC board (A&M Systems Model 3230) was found to have the potential for overheating and increasing the risk of a fire.


What We Will Do

A&M Systems, Inc., will replace the defective parts at no cost to the customer. A&M Systems, Inc., will also reimburse the customer for the time to replace any model 3230 PC Board, up to one hour.
