



IMPORTANT SAFETY RECALL INFORMATION

December, 2015

Dear Maserati Dealer:

This notice is sent to you in accordance with the requirements of the National Traffic and Motor Vehicle Safety Act (in the US) and the Motor Vehicle Safety Act (in Canada).

Maserati S.p.A. and MNA have determined that a safety defect which relates to motor vehicle safety exists in certain model year 2016 Granturismo and Granturismo convertible models. The affected vehicles were manufactured with a main fuel delivery line which was not galvanized treated. A non-galvanized treated main fuel delivery line will be susceptible to corrosion.

Through normal vehicle use and exposure to the elements, especially during the winter months where road-salt will be used for de-icing of the roadways, a non-galvanized main fuel delivery line will corrode and can leak fuel. If the leaked fuel comes into contact with an ignition source, there is potential for a vehicle fire.

The remedy for the affected vehicles involves the replacement of the main fuel delivery line. The remedy procedure will take approximately 1 hour to be completed and will be performed free of charge to the vehicle owner.

If you have already sold any of the vehicles with the indicated VIN in the enclosed instructions and have not yet sent in the new owner information to MNA, please do so at once so we may notify these owners.
