Suzuki Motor Corporation has instituted a safety recall campaign to inspect and possibly replace the tappets and camshafts on select units.

During assembly, the tappets may have been exposed to contaminants, which can cause the surface of the tappets and the cams to wear prematurely. Premature wear of the tappets and cams can result in excessive valve clearance, which can result in possible stalling and increase the risk of a crash.

Excessive valve clearance can also cause the vehicle to fall out of emissions compliance, so this defect is being addressed as both a Safety Recall Campaign and an Emissions Recall Campaign.

IT IS A VIOLATION OF FEDERAL LAW TO DELIVER ANY NEW VEHICLE SUBJECT TO A SAFETY RECALL CAMPAIGN UNTIL THE DEFECT OR NONCOMPLIANCE HAS BEEN CORRECTED. ADDITIONALLY, SELLING A NON-REPAIRED UNIT IS A DIRECT VIOLATION OF YOUR SUZUKI DEALER AGREEMENT AND MAY LEAD TO ADDITIONAL SANCTIONS.

#### Parts Availability:

Dealers will be able to order the necessary parts to perform this recall campaign beginning approximately the week of January 25, 2015.
