# IMPORTANT SAFETY RECALL

### OWNER NOTIFICATION

NHTSA Recall 15V-012

Dear Nissan Pathfinder Owner:

This notice is sent to you in accordance with the requirements of the National Traffic and Motor Vehicle Safety Act. Nissan has decided that a defect which relates to motor vehicle safety exists in certain 2014-2015 model year Nissan Pathfinder vehicles. Our records indicate that you own or lease the Nissan vehicle identified by the VIN inside of this notice.

#### Reason for Recall

Due to a manufacturing process error on certain 2014-2015 model year Pathfinder vehicles, the front wheel hub assembly bolts may not have been tightened to specification. If left uncorrected, the bolts may loosen and the brake caliper may separate from the wheel assembly, potentially reducing braking performance and steering control which could increase a risk of a crash.

### What Nissan Will Do

Your Nissan dealer will inspect all front wheel hub assembly bolts for the proper torque specification. If any bolts are loose, they will be tightened to the correct specification. This service, free for parts and labor, should take 30 minutes to complete, but your Nissan dealer may require your vehicle for a longer period of time based upon their work schedule.

## What You Should Do

Contact your Nissan dealer at your earliest convenience in order to arrange an appointment to have your vehicle repaired. Please bring this notice with you when you keep your service appointment. Instructions have been sent to your Nissan dealer.
