

**RECREATIONAL VEHICLE SAFETY RECALL NOTICE** Safety Recall: 15V-035 February 4, 2015

## **IMPORTANT SAFETY RECALL**

This notice is sent to you in accordance with the requirements of the National Traffic and Motor Vehicle Safety Act. CrossRoads RV (CrossRoads) has decided that a defect which relates to motor vehicle safety exists in certain model 2015 Z-1 travel trailers. As a result, CrossRoads is conducting a safety recall. We apologize for any inconvenience this action may cause you; however your safety and continued satisfaction are of the utmost importance to us.

Reason for this recall	It has been decided that certain Z-1 travel trailers were built with the incorrect label on the front loading ramps which indicates the maximum weight allowed on the loading ramps. The incorrect labels indicated a maximum weight rating of 700 lbs. but the correct value should be 500 lbs.
What we will do	CrossRoads has enclosed the corrected labels to remedy the situation.
What we need you to do	At your earliest convenience, apply the new cargo loading labels directly over top of the existing labels on your trailer.
