



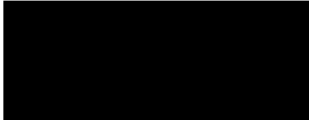

IMPORTANT SAFETY RECALL

Subject: Safety Recall 15KWA – Caliper Bolts Loose
NHTSA Recall number: 15V-051
This notice applies to your vehicle; VIN: 3WKD[REDACTED]



Dear Kenworth Customer,

This notice is sent to you in accordance with the requirements of the National Traffic and Motor Vehicle Safety Act.

Kenworth Truck Company has decided that a defect which relates to motor vehicle safety exists in certain model year 2015 K270, K370, T660, T800, and T880 vehicles manufactured between 07/21/2014 and 09/16/2014.

On K270, K370, T660, T800, and T880 vehicles built during the time period indicated above, brake caliper bolts may not have been properly torqued. The loss of the brake caliper bolts may result in the loss of service brake effectiveness and increases the risk of a fire, crash and/or personal injury and death.

<i>The problem is...</i>	Under-torqued brake caliper mounting bolts.
<i>What your dealer will do...</i>	Inspect for and replace any missing disc brake caliper bolts and tighten all caliper bolts on suspect trucks.
<i>What you must do ...</i>	Contact your Kenworth Dealer to schedule an appointment for repair.

Kenworth has initiated a recall to inspect for and replace any missing disc brake caliper bolts and tighten all caliper bolts. This repair should take approximately 1 hour and will be performed at no charge to you. Please contact your Kenworth dealer immediately to schedule an appointment for this repair. To find your nearest Kenworth dealer, please visit Dealer Locator at www.Kenworth.com. If you had this repair performed before you received this letter, you may be eligible to receive reimbursement for the cost of obtaining a pre-notification remedy of the problem associated with this recall.

If you no longer own this vehicle, we would appreciate your advising us of the new owner if you know their name. The enclosed card may be used for this purpose.
