IMPORTANT SAFETY RECALL

OWNER NOTIFICATION

NHTSA Recall 15V-054

Dear Nissan GT-R Owner:

This notice is sent to you in accordance with the National Traffic and Motor Vehicle Safety Act. Nissan has decided that a defect which relates to motor vehicle safety exists in certain 2009 model year Nissan GT-R vehicles. Our records indicate that you own or lease the Nissan vehicle identified by the VIN inside of this notice.

Reason for Recall

Certain 2009 model year GT-R vehicles including yours may have been manufactured with an out of specification steering column assembly component. This issue may lead to excessive play in the steering wheel. If this occurs, you may notice extra looseness in the steering. If this condition is ignored and, if an excessive load is applied to pull the steering wheel towards the driver, this could lead to loss of steering control and increase the risk of a crash.

What Nissan Will Do

Your Nissan dealer will replace the steering column assembly. This service is free of charge for parts and labor. It should take 2 hours to complete, but your Nissan dealer may require your vehicle for a longer period of time based upon their work schedule.

What You Should Do

Contact your Certified Nissan GT-R dealer at your earliest convenience in order to arrange an appointment to have your vehicle repaired. If you hear grinding noises coming from the steering column area, or notice extra looseness in the steering, or unusual upward or downward movement of the steering assembly, please STOP DRIVING and call the GT-R hotline at 866-668-1487 or your Certified Nissan GT-R dealer immediately to arrange for towing service.

Please bring this notice with you when you keep your service appointment. Instructions have been sent to your Nissan dealer.
