IMPORTANT SAFETY RECALL

Subject: Agility CNG Fuel System Hoses

This notice is sent to you in accordance with the National Traffic and Motor Vehicle Safety Act.

Daimler Trucks North America LLC, on behalf of its Freightliner Trucks Division, has decided that a defect which relates to motor vehicle safety exists on specific Freightliner Cascadia model vehicles manufactured November 19, 2013 through December 13, 2013.

The stainless steel braid reinforcement on some of the Motion Industries T1700-06 flexible fuel hoses used in certain fuel system applications may be susceptible to premature corrosion near the fitting crimp inside the slave tank enclosure, possibly due to a combination of the accumulation of road salt and the humid environment within the enclosure. If the corrosion progresses and remains undetected, the hoses may leak in sufficient volumes to create a risk of fire if an ignition source is present.

Affected hoses will be replaced by Agility Fuel Systems.

If you do not own the vehicle that corresponds to the identification number(s) which appears on the Recall Notification, please return the notification to the Warranty Campaigns Department with any information you can furnish that will assist us in locating the present owner. If you have leased this vehicle, Federal law requires that you forward this notice to the lessee within 10 days. If you are a subsequent stage manufacturer, Federal law requires that you forward this notice to your distributors and retail outlets within five working days.

If you are not able to have the defect remedied without charge and within a reasonable time, you may wish to submit a complaint to the Administrator, National Highway Traffic Safety Administration, 1200 New Jersey Avenue, SE., Washington, DC 20590; or call the Vehicle Safety Hotline at (888) 327-4236 (TTY: 800-424-9153); or to <http://www.safercar.gov>.
