# Why is your vehicle being recalled?

In certain of these vehicles, the steering column assembly housing may come into contact with the power steering printed circuit board. This contact could eventually cause enough wear on the power steering printed circuit board to cause a sudden loss of power steering assist. If power steering assist is lost, steering control can still be maintained but would require an increased steering effort, which presents a greater risk of a crash. If power steering assist is lost or reduced, a malfunction indicator light displays on the instrument panel to inform the driver.

### What will we do?

Your GM dealer will inspect and, if necessary, replace the steering column assembly. This service will be performed for you at **no charge**. Because of service scheduling requirements, it is likely that your dealer will need your vehicle longer than the actual inspection time of approximately fifteen minutes. If part replacement is required, an additional one hour and ten minutes may be required.

# What should you do?

You should contact your GM dealer to arrange a service appointment as soon as possible.
